

Make the most of overnights in Honolulu and Papeete, exploring above and below the surface, from helicopters to submarines.


#### SERENE DISCOVERIES

The cultural importance of this site, with the marae complex (meeting grounds) located at its heart, offers fascinating insights into Polynesian societies. Taputapuātea holds particular significance and sits at the centre of the "Polynesian Triangle."

# AUSTRALIA & NEW ZEALAND

Australia and New Zealand capture the heart of adventure and culture in some of the most unique and captivating ways.

The joyful thrill and awe of Australia's iconic wildlife leaping from the water, hopping across the outback and snuggling into the heart of a eucalyptus tree never goes away. UNESCO World Heritage Sites abound throughout this incredible wilderness, highlighting the habitats of these wondrous animals, from the Tasmanian Wilderness and the Gondwana Rainforests to the gem of the Coral Sea, the Great Barrier Reef.

The rugged beauty and starkly contrasting landscapes of New Zealand inspire thoughts of fantastical tales and an inspiring sense of both reverence and responsibility toward caring for the homes of the irreplaceable fauna found on the islands of the Kiwis.

#### VERDANT ADVENTURES

#### New Zealand

Dazzling, with kaleidoscopic natural scenes, the landscape of New Zealand's **Te Wahipounamu** has been shaped by successive glaciations into fjords, rocky coasts, towering cliffs, lakes and waterfalls. The breathtaking beauty of **Milford Sound** will be your first glimpse into this UNESCOprotected wonderland as you sail through the pristine mountain-fed waters. Forested cliffs soar above you in every direction with cascading falls casting rainbows in the sunlight.

#### Australia

The Wet Tropics of Queensland, stretching between Townsville and Cooktown, holds much of Australia's stunning tropical rainforest. Venture into this prehistoric landscape to find a variety of endemic animals and plants, from the world's largest reptiles to what are considered some of the earliest flowering plants on the planet. The jewel of the Wet Tropics is the fantastic Daintree National Park, which can be accessed from Port Douglas, just north of Cairns, the gateway to another UNESCO Site: the Great Barrier Reef.



## SOUTHEAST ASIA & CHINA

The vibrancy and spice of the local cultures exudes from every port of call visited throughout Southeast Asia.

Savour more of each destination with overnights in Bali, Bangkok, Ho Chi Minh City and Hong Kong, among others. The multimedia show, A *Symphony of Lights*, in Hong Kong's Victoria Harbour delivers a feast for the eyes and heats up the night's sky, while Ho Chi Minh City invites you for an evening out to discover some of the most incredible flavours in all of Vietnam.

Delve into the mystical beauty of the famed temple grounds of Angkor Wat and the Historic City of Ayutthaya where their striking designs, ancient towers and storied pasts ignite the imagination.


#### FLAVOURFUL EXPEDITIONS

#### Thailand

The **Bangkok street food** scene is known the world over.
