## HONOLULU, HAWAII (JANUARY 20-21, 2022)

The dazzling resorts along Waikiki's crescent beach and the verdant peak of Diamond Head depict the iconic image of Polynesia for travelers worldwide. The city specializes in entertaining and edifying visitors with scintillating nightlife, world-class restaurants and a wealth of unique attractions including the Bishop Museum, the ornate Iolani Palace, Doris Duke's enchanting Shangri-La museum of Islamic art and culture and the spectacular and moving Pearl Harbor National Memorial.

Your two-day stay offers a chance to explore the Reef's vast, subaquatic ecosystem, teeming with vividly colored tropical fishes, and the nearby, primeval Daintree Rainforest National Park, both of which are inscribed UNESCO World Heritage sites.



## DARWIN, NORTHERN TERRITORY, AUSTRALIA (MARCH 4-5, 2022)

Plucky little Darwin embodies the independent pioneer spirit of Crocodile Dundee. Located on the tropical rim of the continent, it has endured cyclones and war, and come through with a wry and engaging sense of humor. This is a great place to learn more about the indigenous Aborigines and see some of their fascinating artworks. It's also a good place to get familiar with the regional wildlife, and especially the unique "jumping crocodiles" that frequent its tidal rivers.



### MANILA, PHILIPPINES (MARCH 19-20, 2022)

Teeming Manila embodies the island nation's contrasts of age and modernity, wealth and poverty, Asian and Eurocentric cultures. Fort Santiago is in the 16th-century Spanish colonial Intramuros section, along with the UNESCO-cited San Agustin church. The city boasts dozens of museums displaying everything from art and archaeology to Imelda Marcos' immense collection of shoes. An historic option visits the island WWII battlefield of Corregidor.



### KEELUNG (TAIPEI), TAIWAN (MARCH 24-25, 2022)

The Taipei 101 skyscraper towers over one of Asia's most prodigious metropolises. The fashionable Shi-men Ting shops coexist with a variety of popular and bustling night markets. Ornate traditional temples are echoed by elaborate memorials to Chiang Kai Shek and Dr. Sun Yat Sen. The National Palace Museum holds the largest collection of Chinese Imperial treasures outside China. Nearby Taroko National Park thrills visitors with a breathtaking gorge cut through a marble mountain.



### BUSAN (PUSAN), SOUTH KOREA (APRIL 3-4, 2022)

South Korea's second-largest city greets you with a graceful curve of its popular Haeundae Beach and the sinuous Diamond Bridge. Mountain ridges intrude from above, threaded with picturesque cable cars over cherry blossoms and traditional temples such as Beomeosa. In the Jagalchi Fish Market, you can order from a multicolored array of seafoods and ascend a stairway to have your selection served fresh. Korea's capitol city of Seoul invites an optional overnight exploration by high-speed train.



### NAGASAKI, JAPAN (APRIL 6-7, 2022)

Once the only Japanese port open to foreign trade, Nagasaki acquired a unique multicultural character. The Western-style homes on Dutch Slope housed early Dutch and European merchants. The city also boasts two Chinese-style Zen Buddhist temples and a still-active Chinatown. The white Oura Church, Japan's oldest, is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Glover Garden gained fame from Madame Butterfly, while the moving Nagasaki Peace Park recalls the devastating atomic bomb attack in 1945.



### SHANGHAI, CHINA (APRIL 9-11, 2022)

Lining both banks of the Huangpu tributary of the Yangtze River sprawls China's largest city, the financial hub and dynamic showplace of the People's Republic. On one side stand the colonial-era bastions of the Bund, many of which now house museums. The Pudong side's architectural splendors include the spiraling glass Shanghai Tower and the stacked pink spheres of the Oriental Pearl TV Tower, both of which offer breathtaking views from lofty observation levels. The Yuyuan Gardens are a tranquil Ming dynasty fantasy, and your visit coincides with the splendid annual International Flower Show at the Shanghai Botanical Gardens. In contrast, the warren of alleyways in Tianzifang and Xintiandi offer hip boutiques and restaurants in converted traditional houses. Aside from Pudong's dazzling illuminated skyline, Shanghai nightlife offers dining that rates its own Michelin Guide, famous acrobatic and Chinese opera performances, and jazz and nightclub action. Boat tours on the riverfront and sorties to the nearby, rustic Qibao village are also popular options for visitors.

## HONG KONG, CHINA (APRIL 15-16, 2022)

Tours by kayak and traditional junks are popular. The town offers nightlife of its own, with bars, nightclubs and casinos, and Vietnam's capital of Hanoi is accessible via a recently enhanced highway.



## HO CHI MINH CITY, VIETNAM (APRIL 23-24, 2022)

Your nimble Seabourn Sojourn sails right up the Saigon River to the heart of Ho Chi Minh City. Its broad, Parisian-style boulevards, alive with rivers of motorbikes and lined with amiable shop-houses, are just steps away. The colonial-period palace/museums and hotels are nearby as well. Investigate the Cu Chi Tunnels from the revolutionary war, browse the colorful markets, visit a lacquer workshop or opt for a boat tour in the fertile 'rice bowl' of the Mekong Delta.



## LAEM CHABANG (BANGKOK), THAILAND (APRIL 28-29, 2022)

Laem Chabang is your gateway to Thailand's capital, which rewards visitors with an endless flow of amazing sights and cheerful encounters. Treasures like the fairytale Grand Palace, Wat Arun and the Emerald Buddha cluster side-by-side with mazelike malls, seductively fragrant food stalls and emporia of jewel-bright Thai silks. Pattaya beach resorts are closer by, with surprises including the Sanctuary of Truth, a temple constructed of elaborately hand-carved wood sculptures.



## SINGAPORE (MAY 2-3, 2022)

The Merlion city-state blends Malay, Chinese and Indian heritage to create a hybrid culture unlike any other. The glittering towers of Marina Bay and the Supertree Grove in Gardens by the Bay are your introduction to its marvels. Chinatown, Arab Street and the retail mecca of Orchard Road entice you to explore. Dine on anything from traditional Straits to haute cuisine, visit the Jurong Bird Park and enjoy a thrilling night safari in a unique nocturnal zoo.



### COLOMBO, SRI LANKA (MAY 11-12, 2022)

Famous for the tea from its slopes and precious rubies and sapphires, Sri Lanka's heritage of colonial Dutch and British buildings like the 18th-century Wolvendaal Church mingle with Buddhist pagodas, colorful Jain temples, Islamic mosques, and vigorous renovation and new construction. The candy-striped Jami-UI-Alfar Mosque, the bustling markets of Pettah and the National Museum might augment a visit to the Temple of Buddha's Tooth at Kandy in the highlands.



### MALÉ, MALDIVES (MAY 14-15, 2022)

A garland of 2,000 coral atolls floating in the Indian Ocean, the Maldives are the vision of a castaway paradise, surrounded by reefs from which people cut the blocks to build their homes. Malé has been a way-station for the far-ranging Indian Ocean dhow trade for centuries, witness the shards of Ming pottery studded into Malé's walls. Today the islands are one of the world's premier resort destinations, with luxuries, services and facilities to match their sheer, rapturous beauty.



### SAFAGA (LUXOR), EGYPT (MAY 24-25, 2022)

Ancient tracks of Roman chariots still scar Egypt's Eastern Desert. Following their path from the Red Sea to the Nile you come, as did the Romans, upon the lotus-crowned colonnades and towering granite obelisks that announce great Thebes. Nowhere is the grandeur of ancient Egyptian culture more prolifically displayed. In Karnak and Luxor temples, and in the tombs and monuments of the Valley of the Kings and Queens you will discover images, ideas and aspirations linking humankind across immense oceans of time.



### HAIFA (TEL AVIV, NAZARETH), ISRAEL (MAY 30-31, 2022)

Haifa's beautiful Mediterranean bay is Israel's primary port and your gateway to the biblical and historical sites of the Holy Land. Tel Aviv's UNESCO-inscribed White City, bustling markets and pleasant waterfront are close by, as is Jerusalem, sacred to more than a third of humankind, with its Western Wall, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, Dome of the Rock and the Yad Vashem Memorial Museum. Galilee, Bethlehem, Acre and Nazareth, the river Jordan, and Masada are nearby as well.

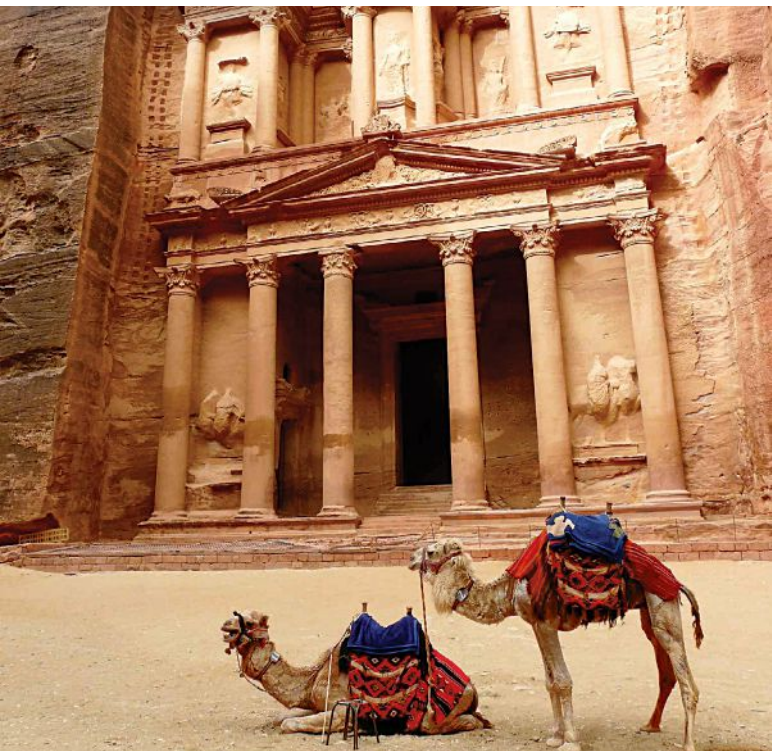

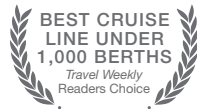
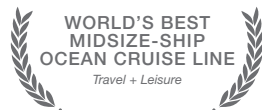
