QUÉBEC CITY, CANADA

FRENCH-CANADIAN COUNTRYSIDE

Beyond the charm of downtown, Mother Nature reigns supreme in the pristine countryside surrounding Québec City. Recognised by UNESCO for the forces that formed its striking landscape – millions of years of glacial erosion, the collision of a huge meteorite and an ancient sea that smoothed the land – Baie-Comeau offers breathtaking vistas from every vantage point within a biosphere reserve in the Côte-Nord region of Québec. Enjoy views of another kind by Florentine artist Guido Nincheri at Sainte-Amélie Church, rich with his frescoes and stained glass. After a fresh seafood lunch in the city's heritage district, head to St-Pancrace microbrewery for a local craft beer, perhaps mustering up the courage to try a speciality bitter brewed with crab shells.

EASTPORT, MAINE

The epitome of a 'downeast' Maine fishing town, tiny
Eastport on Moose Island boasts the deepest natural
seaport in the continental US and a walkable downtown
that recalls the city's late-19th century heyday as a

sardine exporter. A collection of quirky shops and restaurants serving locally caught seafood and lobster beckon from 29 National Historic Register buildings. Stop by the Tides Institute & Museum of Art for an appreciation of Passamaquoddy Bay area culture and creativity.

FERNANDINA BEACH, FLORIDA

Situated on moss-draped Amelia Island at Florida's north-east border, Fernandina Beach has been drawing jet-setters since the late-19th century, when industrialist Henry Flagler converted the island into a gathering place for the wealthy. You'll appreciate Flagler's legacy wandering past historic buildings, eclectic shops and Victorian B&Bs in Fernandina Beach's quaint downtown. Local, wild-caught shrimp highlight the menus of an inviting assortment of restaurants, while lush parks and miles of shoreline beckon you to revel in Amelia Island's natural beauty.

where a mural was found showing the
astronomical positions of the planet Venus.
For those seeking a unique view, climb the
vast Gran Basamento, which takes you
above tree level and is the location where
archaeologists found ceremonial offerings
dating to around 1000 B.C.



FEATURED New Ports of Call

IZMIR, TURKEY

Curled around a cerulean bay, Izmir buzzes with a remarkably cosmopolitan vibe considering its estimated 4,000 years of history. Soak up the sublime Mediterranean atmosphere along a café-laden waterfront, savouring *boyoz*, *kumru*, *kokoreç* and *lokma* ('king of desserts') over Turkish coffee. Haggle at historic Kemeralti Bazaar, visit Izmir's archaeological museum and ride a *teleferic* (cable car) for panoramic views of the 'Pearl of the Aegean'.

MARMARIS, TURKEY

With an azure-blue sea lapping golden beaches, a multitude of wood-hulled yachts bobbing in marinas and pine-covered hillsides framing it all, Marmaris earns its stripes as a popular resort town. Take in the views along the walls and ramparts of Marmaris Castle before stopping off at its artefact-rich museum, then head to the waterfront for dizzying varieties of Greek and Turkish food – and maybe a sip of ouzo.

PUERTO BANÚS, SPAIN

Simply put, the most glamorous marina on Spain's Costa del Sol. Built by a local property developer in 1970, Puerto Banús today draws five million visitors annually to its high-end shopping malls, bars and restaurants. Put on your best celebrity sunglasses and promenade along Muelle de Ribera, the epicentre of exclusive boutiques and designer fashion shops.

SYROS, GREECE

If Santorini and Mykonos are the superstars of the Cyclade Islands, Syros is its bastion of authentic Greek life. Founded during the Greek Revolution in the 1820s, the capital city of Ermoupoli is a dreamscape of pastel-coloured neoclassical buildings and grand churches. Savour the 'Duchess of the Aegean' with visits to Plateia Miaouli, Ermoupoli's marble-paved square; St. George's (Grenada) Cathedral atop the medieval hilltop settlement of Ano Syros; and Vaporia, the city's most picturesque quarter.



NAPLES, ITALY

ANCIENT POMPEII

Journey along the crescent-shaped Gulf of Naples to fabled UNESCO World Heritage site Pompeii, a Roman town buried under ash and pumice by the catastrophic Mount Vesuvius eruption of AD 79. As you walk through the remains of the forum, private homes and shops, you'll gain a clear picture of daily life nearly 2,000 years ago. Marvel at frescoes and mosaics adorning largely intact villas, and observe the aftermath of the eruption, nearly undisturbed since the classical era. You'll feel as if time has frozen here. On your return, pass by scenic coastal communities and conclude with a stop at a purveyor of cameo jewellery, a tradition that epitomises this region's imaginative spirit.



FREE SHORE EXCURSION

VALLETTA, MALTA

ISLAND OF GOZO

After a brief ferry ride, delight in an exploration of the nearby island of Gozo. Journey inland to the Ggantija Temples, a UNESCO World Heritage site that comprises Malta's earliest megalithic monuments, including structures that predate Stonehenge and the Great Pyramids of Egypt. Spend time exploring the curved architecture, said to be an homage to the full-figured goddess of fertility, before visiting Calypso Cave. This is thought to be the cave Homer mentioned in *The Odyssey*. Venture to Victoria, Gozo's capital, to view its ancient Cittadella and Baroque Cathedral of the Assumption, then savour a traditional Maltese lunch. You'll finish with some time to explore Xlendi's inviting seaside promenade.

FEATURED New Port of Call

LEKNES, NORWAY

It's easy to envision being at the helm of a Viking warship as you approach the Lofoten Islands along Norway's northern coast (north, in fact, of the Arctic Circle). Stark, jagged mountains stand against the sky and deep fjords drop to sheltered bays and long, windswept beaches. Small villages and sheep pastures appear as you near Leknes, a small town of under 4,000 nestled on the island of Vestvågøy. In this land of auroras in winter and the midnight sun in summer, wild nature abounds – watch for the rare sea eagles flying overhead. In town, admire the work of local artists drawn by the stunning surroundings and enjoy a taste of stockfish – dried cod that dates to the Viking days and staple of the Norwegian diet.

FREE SHORE EXCURSION

KOTKA, FINLAND

RELAXING RIVER KYMIJOKI

Cruise down the free-flowing Kymijoki River in an open raft for a spectacularly scenic outdoor experience. The longest river in Finland, the Kymi, as it is known familiarly, flows through the beautiful, forested countryside to the gulf of Kotka. Finland was part of Sweden from the 12th century to 1809, during which time the river formed the border between Sweden and Russia. Today, Kymi attracts outdoor enthusiasts and chances are you will see kayakers, canoers or anglers trying to catch salmon as you raft down the calm waters. After an idyllic time on the river, stop for a lunch of flambeéd salmon and traditional Finnish coffee, both prepared over a campfire.

FEATURED New Ports of Call

ITAJAÍ, BRAZIL

Sitting at the mouth of the scenic Rio Itajaí, this cosmopolitan city between São Paulo and the Uruguayan border offers a culture-rich respite from the frenetic pace of Brazil's larger cities. Founded by mid-18th century Portuguese settlers, the bayside city received an influx of German immigrants a hundred years later, perhaps ensuring the region's proliferation of excellent wineries and breweries. The distinctive design of architect Frank Gehry greets your arrival at BioMuseo, the world's first biodiversity museum that vividly tells Panama's biological history. Discover a trove of artefacts and information on the planning, construction and operation of the 'Big Ditch' at the interactive Panama Canal Museum, and pay homage to the 22,000 workers who died building the canal from 1899 to 1913 at the impressive Plaza de Francia.





Unspoiled Walvis Bay, a natural lagoon, is the only deep-sea harbour on the Namibian coast. Discovered by Portuguese explorer Bartolomeo Dias in 1487, it's known for its spectacular array of migrating and local birds. Take a short drive out of town to Dune 7, the tallest sand dune in the Namib Desert at over 1,200 feet, for amazing views and spectacular photos. Then tour the Walvis Bay Salt Refiners, which produces over 700,000 tonnes of salt every year, imported by countries all over the world. Continue exploring with a drive into Namib Naukluft National Park, the country's largest nature preserve, which is full of windswept sand dunes, the sand-diving lizard, the Namaqua chameleon, and "the world's ugliest plant", the welwitschia.
