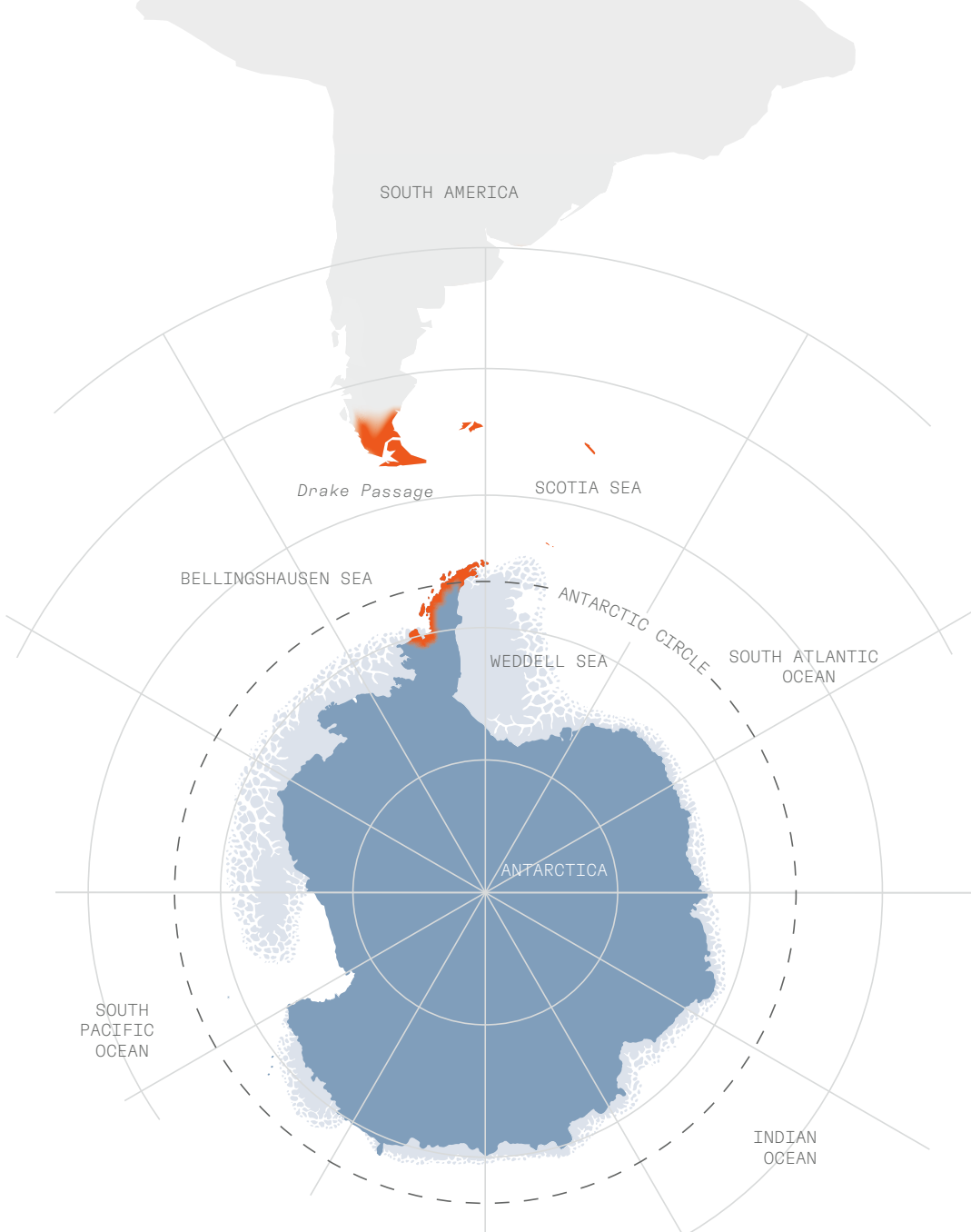

Boundless, awe-inspiring and of a beauty that is reserved for only a few: that's the Antarctic. Not a normal travel destination – but a world of emotions. Anyone who dares embark on an expedition here will immediately realise that this is not just about seeing, but feeling. The cracking of the ice beneath the bow, the silent passing of an iceberg, the sight of penguin colonies with thousands of animals – all of this touches the soul profoundly.

Every one of our Antarctic cruises take place in the austral summer. Our captains and crews adapt the route to the weather and ice every day. In close cooperation with the Federal Environment Agency, we offer the best possible experiences with the least possible impact on nature.



We at Hapag-Lloyd Cruises have been exploring the southern polar region for over 30 years. Some members of our teams have visited the area more than 100 times – and yet each time they speak of a new discovery. Let yourself be intoxicated by an almost unearthly landscape dominated by wildlife: countless penguins, mighty elephant seals and whales as well as many species of seabirds.

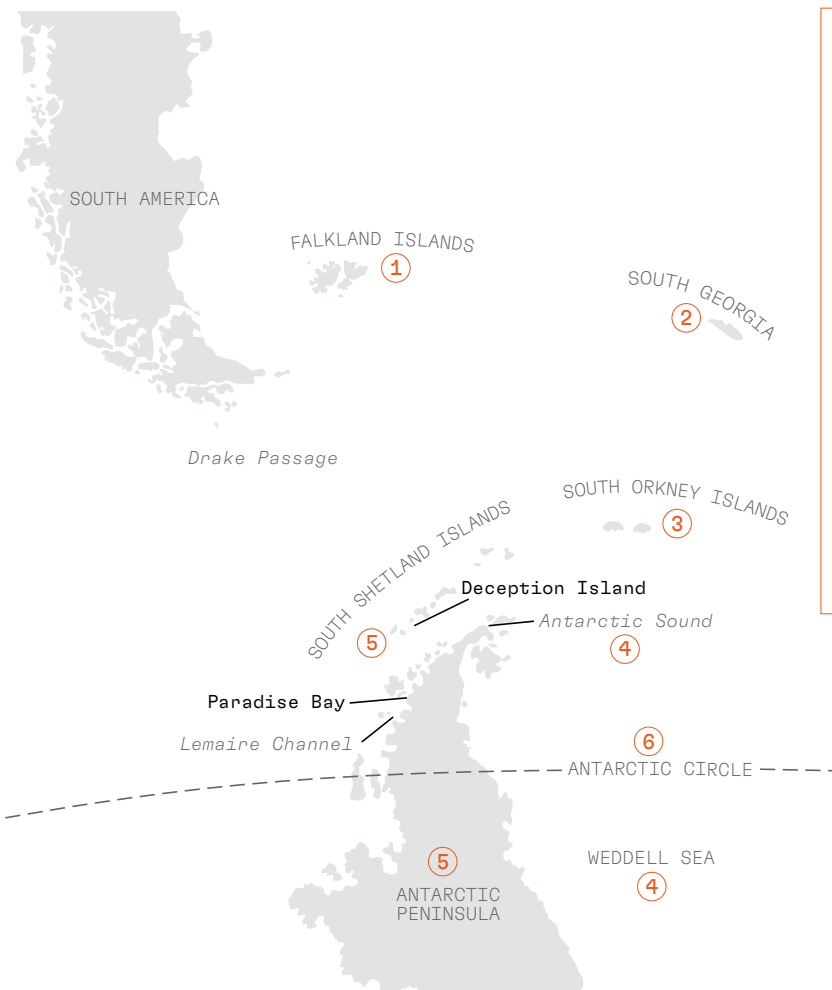

1 FALKLAND ISLANDS

Experience this incredible bird paradise, which is home to around 60 species, at close range during Zodiac landings. Observe rockhopper and Magellanic penguins, who share their habitat with kelp geese, striated caracaras, king cormorants as well as black-browed and wandering albatrosses.



WHERE REGIONS GIVE RISE TO STORIES



2 SOUTH GEORGIA

Hundreds of thousands of king penguins live side by side with elephant seals and fur seals on the coasts and cliffs – overwhelming natural spectacles that you can observe from a respectful distance after landing on one of the black shores. Trace the footsteps of the explorer Sir Ernest Shackleton, who found his final resting place here in 1922.





3 SOUTH ORKNEY ISLANDS

The South Orkney Islands are a lonely world of icy wilderness in the Scotia Sea. They are home to chinstrap and Adelie penguins. With luck, you will also see icebergs drifting off the rugged coast. Find out how the polar explorers live at the Argentinian Orcadas Station (depending on weather and authorisation).

4 ANTARCTIC SOUND AND WEDDELL SEA

Icebergs ahead: at the bow and on the open deck areas, you can enjoy the best views. You may even spot blue whales, sperm whales and humpback whales as well as orcas. The Weddell Sea features stunning ice formations – whether as sparkling blue-and-white sculptures, gigantic tabular icebergs or creaking sheets of dense pack ice.



5 SOUTH SHETLAND ISLANDS AND ANTARCTIC PENINSULA

Experience a region between ice and awe intensively – on deck as well as by Zodiac. Off the Antarctic Peninsula, your expedition ship sails into the centre of the flooded caldera of Deception Island. Majestic glaciers and gigantic icebergs shimmer in Paradise Bay. The Lemaire Channel is also impressive, flanked by mighty mountains up to 1,000 m (3,281 ft) high.

6 ANTARCTIC CIRCLE

The further south your expedition goes, the harsher and icier the white appears. The excitement on board mounts as you approach the crossing of the Antarctic Circle. How far can the ship advance? Thick ice fields and high tabular icebergs are a common sight here. The glaciers seem even more dominant in this icy domain. A unique feeling of pioneering adventure.



THE ICE IS SILENT . . .



PENGUINS

Curious, loud and lovable: penguins are the hidden stars of every Antarctic cruise. Whether clumsily waddling along their favourite path or jumping head first into the water – their closeness is touching. Hundreds of thousands of chattering king penguins await you on South Georgia, crowding together and breeding here. An unforgettable welcoming committee.



SEALS

You will often encounter pinnipeds on your expedition. Sometimes they glide curiously past the Zodiac, sometimes they rest on an ice floe. Particularly endearing: a Weddell seal relaxing in the sun – as if there were no yesterday and no tomorrow, only this very moment.

WHALES

A giant body glides gracefully through the water, a deep burst of breath breaking the silence. The fluke rises and falls as if in slow motion. This is an experience of nature you might witness on your expedition. When the marine mammals appear, the captain flexibly changes the course of the ship.



SEABIRDS

They hover above the ship, carried by the wind and seemingly weightless: albatrosses, petrels and skuas accompany you on your adventure – often for hours on end. There are around 275 species of seabirds living in the southern polar waters. At the time of your expedition, many come ashore to mate, build nests and breed. And they all make you sense that the magic of the Antarctic is in the air as well.

KNOWLEDGE THAT MOVES – AND LINGERS

Experience, curiosity and true passion for this extraordinary continent. An expedition team of up to 16 members allows you to immerse yourself in the experience even more profoundly, be it when looking through binoculars, hiking or riding in a Zodiac. Whether on land or on board, such as in the Ocean Academy – the experts share their knowledge with great enthusiasm. They tell fascinating stories behind the glaciers and explain animal behaviour and details about the climate and geology with a passion that is palpable. The excitement in your small group continues after the Zodiac lands ashore. On a snowshoe hike with your experts, you will experience the challenges historical explorers once had to face. The hike rewards you with stunning vantage points and fascinating wildlife observations. Your onward journey takes you past an iceberg from which Adelie penguins jump head first into the water.



Back on board, your sense of discovery continues in comfort. A sparkling blue-and-white world stretches out before you, which you can enjoy on the many open deck areas. In the afternoon, you will again take to the Zodiacs and head right back into the spectacular icy landscape. A seal basks in the sun on an ice floe. The coloured nuances of the ice differ from any familiar scale, and you will be amazed at the frozen works of natural art. You can then consolidate your many experiences in the ship's Ocean Academy and at presentations given in the evenings by your experts with a view of the next expedition day.

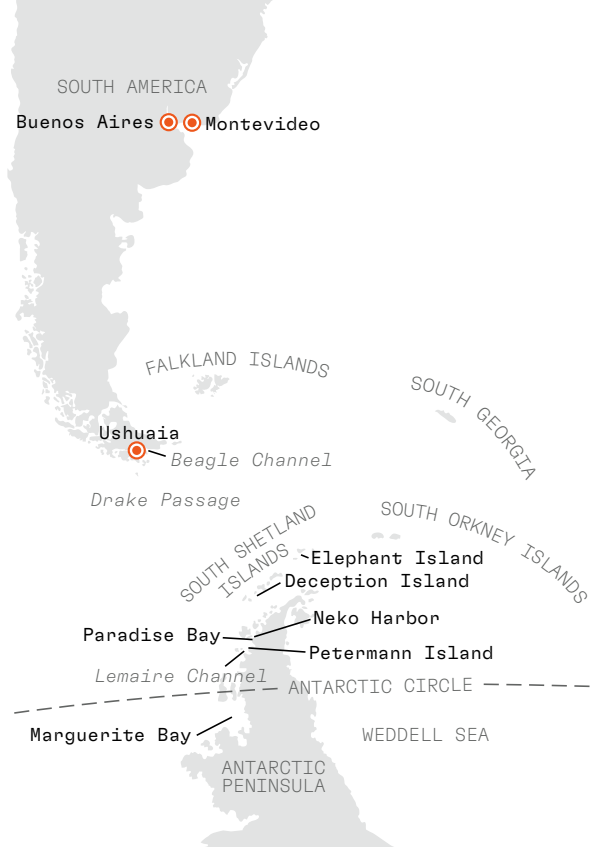

The prologue to your adventures lies in Bergen, with its narrow lanes of the dreamy Hanseatic quarter of Bryggen. On board the HANSEATIC nature, you can look forward to some fantastic experiences. Hugging the coast, your ship will navigate Norway's Inside Passage through breathtaking fjords with high rock faces and waterfalls. The Vester-alen, an archipelago of more than 1,300 islands, will enchant you with rugged mountains, endless shores and unspoilt fishing villages. Under the midnight sun, your days of discovery seem endless – as do your explorations in Tromsø: your ship will have an overnight lay time in the “Paris of the north”.



After cruising off the North Cape, you will continue far into the Arctic Ocean to the north-western coast of Svalbard, where the weather and ice conditions determine the course of your route. Time and again, the Zodiacs bring you ashore, where you will follow in the footsteps of Roald Amundsen and set foot on historic ground and the terrain of today's researchers. Keep your eyes peeled during walks with your experts, since geology will be just as much a topic for discussion as fauna. 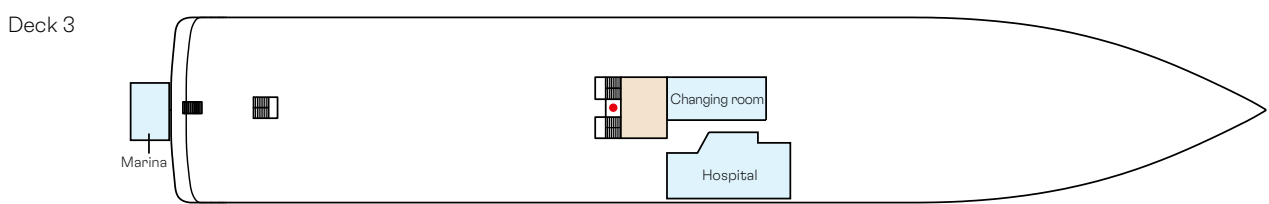
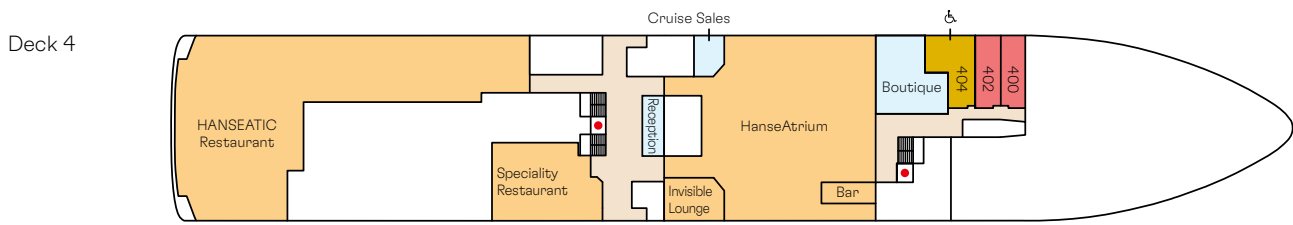
DECK PLAN AND CABIN CATEGORIES

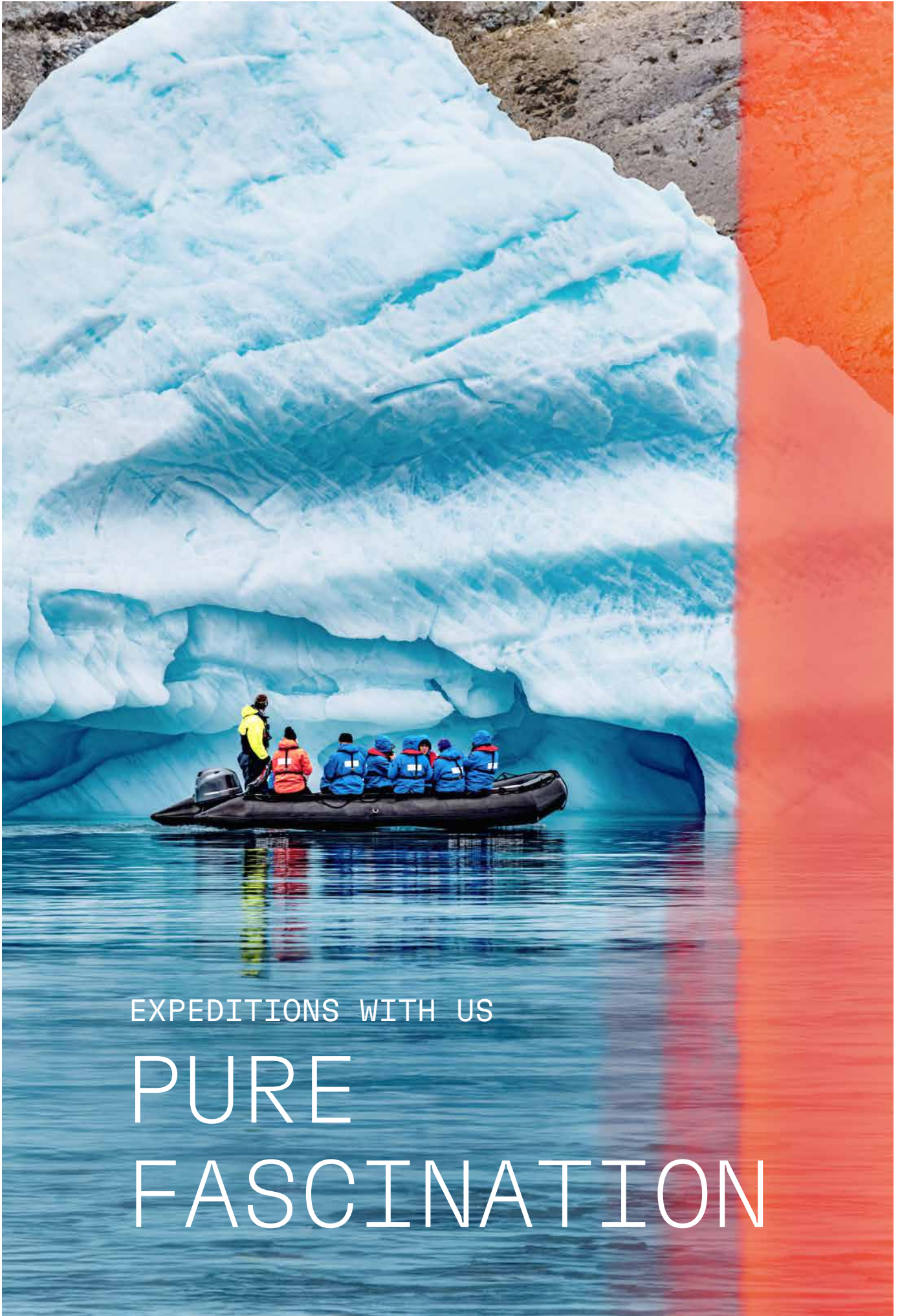
